



Cork Top Step Box Use & Maintenance Instructions

Instructions for:

VR241A	Cork Top Step Box (76 mm/3")
VR236A	Cork Top Step Box (101 mm/4")
VR237A	Cork Top Step Box (127 mm/5")
VR239A	Cork Top Step Box (152 mm/6")

NB. Weight limit: 125 kg (20 stone)

Do not exceed the weight limit stated – doing so could put the user at risk.

1. Bath Steps/General Purpose Steps/Step Boxes

Please examine your Aidapt Cork Top Step Box for any visible damage before use. If you see any damage or suspect a fault, please contact your supplier.

In this case, please do not use your product as it may compromise your safety.

2. Cleaning

All of the product components are manufactured from quality materials. However, it is very important that you only clean your Cork Top Step Box using a non-abrasive cleaner or mild detergent with a soft cloth. Abrasive cleaners e.g. AJAX and or abrasive cleaning pads may seriously damage your product beyond repair.

3. Warnings & Usage

- Ensure that the back of the step is positioned against a solid upright surface to prevent the step from moving forward.
- DO NOT step onto the edge of the step; this may cause it to tip. Always step onto the middle of the step top and ensure that your weight is evenly distributed.
- DO NOT jump onto or off the step.
- Use the step only when dry to reduce the risk of slipping and ensure that the surface beneath the step is dry before use.
- This is not a toy; ensure that children are supervised at all times.

4. Use of Bath Oils

Caution should be observed if you are using any form of bath oils or oily skin preparation with your Cork Top Step Box as this may impair your natural contact skin resistance.

In the event of using any such oil, your Cork Top Step Box must be thoroughly cleaned with a suitable detergent to break down any oily residue. Failure to observe this recommendation could impair your safety.

5. Reissue

If you reissue or are about to reissue this product, please thoroughly check all components for their safety.

This includes:

- Tightness of all nuts/bolts/castors and other screw in/bolt in/push in components.
- Also check all upholstery for security, splits, etc.

If in any doubt, please do not issue or use, but immediately contact your supplier for service support.

6. Maintenance

Please make a safety check of the product at regular intervals or if you have any concerns.
