PRODUCT SAFETY

FUNCTIONS

MP3: Acts as an auxiliary input allowing connection of devices such as MP3 player etc. via a

3.5mm jack socket.

Input: Allows the connection of a guitar or similar instrument via a 6.35mm jack socket

Drive: Causes a distortion effect when pressed

Gain: Increases the distortion effect

Bass: Increases the amount of bass (low frequencies)

Treble: Increases the amount of treble (high frequencies)

Volume: Increases the overall sound volume of the product.

Headphone: Allows connection of a headphone via 6.35mm jack socket.

Power: Switches the power on or off

USE

Before switching on

- 1) Make sure the volume is turned down.
- 2) Connect your instrument to the unit.
- 3) Turn on the unit using the power switch
- 4) Slowly turn the volume control up to the required level
