



GH106 Folding Pet Ramp

Fixing and Maintenance Instructions

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for buying a St. Helens Home and Garden Folding Pet Ramp. Before use please read the manual carefully and keep in a safe place for future reference.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Make sure paws are dry and clear of mud and dirt before use.
- Keep the pet ramp dry and free from dirt and mud.
- Only use on flat stable surfaces. Check the ground at the base of the ramp is firm and does not move when weight is applied to the ramp.
- Old and arthritic dogs should be helped and guided up this ramp.
- Check the ramp and it's hinges for damage before use. If any damage is detected do not use.
- Do not exceed the maximum pet weight of this product (140kg).
- Dogs that have walking ailments or impediments, or other injuries should not use this ramp.
- This ramp should only be used for the purposes intended.
- This ramp must not be used to transport people or wheeled vehicles.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Clean with a damp cloth using mild detergent. Do not use acid or alkali based cleaning products.

SERVICE WARRANTY
