Safety Warnings

- Make sure to use the correct cable and UK Plug
- Before use always inspect the product for wear or damage. If any is detected then do not use and consult your supplier
- Ensure the cable does not cause a trip or snagging hazard.
- Do not connect the extension lead on to another extension lead.
- Do not remove the mains plug and connect direct to the mains power supply.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of 13A
- Take care not to damage the cable or fittings.
- Disconnect from the mains supply when not in use.
- Do not use in damp or wet conditions
- For indoor use only.
- Not suitable for high power devices such as Heaters, Irons or other high wattage devices
- There are no user serviceable parts.
- **Surge protection:** If you are connecting sensitive electronic equipment (such as computers or televisions), consider using an extension lead with surge protection to guard against power surges.
- **The extension lead must be fully unwound before use.**
- **This is not toy. Children under 8 years of age should not use the product. Children over the age of 8 can use the product with adult supervision**

Maintenance

Disconnect from the mains first

Regular Checks: Inspect for wear or damage. Discontinue use if damaged.

Cleaning: Unplug and wipe with a dry cloth. Do not use liquids.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Avoid tight coils and extreme temperatures.
